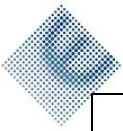




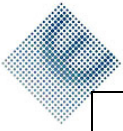

Academic calendar (semesters or terms)	Winter (Fall) Semester: Beginning of October – mid January Summer (Spring) Semester: Mid February – end of May
Exam dates	Depends on the course, no specific examination week that would be generally valid. General examination terms are in January, April, June, September and October.
Holiday dates	Winter Semester: 2 weeks off around New Year and Christmas (Orthodox, on January 7) Summer Semester: 1-2 weeks (Orthodox) Easter holidays in March/April/May

Minimum requirement for incoming students	There is no minimum requirement for visiting/exchange students.
Minimum requirement for outgoing students	We require that our outgoing students complete at least 21 ECTS credits, which equals a minimum of EKOF 3 exams
Are Serbian language courses offered?	Not at the Faculty of Economics. Serbian language courses are offered by the Faculty of Philology University of Belgrade.
Type of accommodation offered	Students dormitory "Rifat Burdzevic" Reservations are made through the host International Office, for those students who are not coming through CEEPUS or ERASMUS.
Costs of Living	Housing: app. € 200 – 250 per month Food, personal expenses: app. € 150 – 200 per month Entertainment: app. € 100 – 150 per month Belgrade public transport: app. € 100 per semester Please note that all figures are estimates, subject to change and individual requirements.
Entry and Residence	Foreign students have to register at the Foreign Citizens Office at the Belgrade local Police Station, within 24 hours of their arrival. Foreigners staying less than 30 consecutive days in Serbia do not need to require a temporary residence permit. However, they do
